



Discussion Questions: Ephesians Chapter 3

1. Read Ephesians 3:1–6

Paul calls the gospel a "mystery" that has now been revealed.

- Why do you think God waited to reveal His plan through Christ?
 - What does this teach us about God's heart for all people?
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2. Read Ephesians 3:7–9

Paul describes himself as the "least of all the saints," yet God entrusted him with an incredible mission.

- How can humility and confidence coexist in a godly man?
 - Have you ever felt unqualified for something God was asking you to do?
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3. Read Ephesians 3:10–13

Paul says God's wisdom is displayed through the church.

- In what ways should the church reflect God's wisdom to the world today?
 - How can men intentionally strengthen the church rather than simply attend it?
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4. Read Ephesians 3:14–17

Paul prays that believers would be strengthened with power through the Spirit.

- What is the difference between physical strength, emotional strength, and spiritual strength?
 - Where do you currently need God's strength the most?
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5. Verse 17 says Christ dwells in our hearts through faith.

- What does it look like, in practice, for Christ to be "at home" in your heart?
 - Are there any areas of your life where you've kept Jesus at the door instead of giving Him full access?
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6. Read Ephesians 3:17–19

Paul prays that believers would grasp the width, length, height, and depth of Christ's love.

- Why is it often easier to understand God's love intellectually than to truly live in it?
 - How would your relationships change if you deeply believed you were fully loved by Christ?
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7. Read Ephesians 3:20–21

God is able to do immeasurably more than we ask or imagine.

- Have you experienced God doing more than you expected? Share your story.
 - What bold prayer have you been hesitant to pray because it feels impossible?
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8. Looking at the entire chapter...

- What stands out most to you about Paul's priorities?
 - If someone watched your life this week, what would they say your greatest priority is?
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
